The confirmation call is very important!

- Only learners who have completed their full Skills Development Programmes and submitted all their Unit Standards or Modules and Resubmissions (Redo's) by the above deadlines may attend the ceremony. A Redo session will be held before 20 July 2020.
- Your fees for your current qualification that you are busy with should also be paid up until where the group received their classes.**
- In some instances, you will be allowed to attend the Award Ceremony if the account & attire is not paid in full by 30/07/2020 – But it remains at the discretion of UCO. If the fees are not paid within 60 days of the ceremony the account will be handed over to our lawyers.
- Indicate your qualification on the tear off slip because the scarf is different for every qualification. Also indicate if you want to buy the scarf for the previous level in the extra scarf block.
- Attire can be collected on the day of the ceremony. Please bring proof of payment and award ceremony invoice with.
- You may bring a maximum of two guests.** We do not charge any money for guests. No refreshments will be served.
- ALL PAYMENTS should be made into the bank account where you deposit your class fees. Use the ATM.
- A professional photographer has been hired who will take photos of every learner before and during the ceremony. You are not allowed to bring your own photographer!
